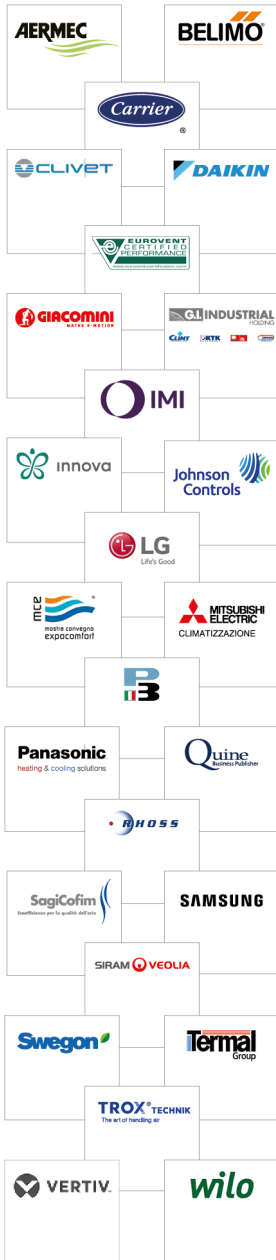

IRCCS Ospedale Galeazzi - Sant'Ambrogio is one of the most renowned healthcare facilities in Italy, known for excellence in orthopaedics, traumatology, and cardiology. The hospital is housed in a brand-new building featuring advanced design, construction, and the use of sophisticated technologies, including IT systems, to ensure high energy efficiency.

Completed in 2022, the new IRCCS Ospedale Galeazzi - Sant'Ambrogio in Milan was built by GSKD Edile, with plant engineering carried out by GALEAZZI IMPIANTI scrl (Gianni Benvenuto-Sinelec-Galli). It is located on the former Expo 2015 site in Milan. The hospital has 600 beds and 32 operating theatres grouped in a single block across 16 floors, reaching a total height of 94 metres. Three additional buildings to the north rise two storeys above ground and house the hospital's technical and auxiliary systems. The complex has received LEED GOLD certification. The technical visit will focus on these technological systems and will provide an opportunity to discuss their features with the companies responsible for their construction and maintenance.
